# Llandaff Festival: 20th – 22nd September 2024

We are pleased to announce that the 2024 Festival will take place at Llandaff Cathedral (in Cardiff South Wales). The Cathedral stands on one of the oldest Christian sites in the British Isles. Worship and prayer have been offered here since the middle of the sixth century. The Director of Music, Stephen Moore, told us that a new Music Foundation has been set up to support and develop music at Llandaff Cathedral. Nick and Alastair have been working closely with Stephen and Elizabeth Atherton (Music Foundation Executive) to set up the 2024 Festival. One of its aims is to engage with former choristers, both those who have left the choirs recently and those who have a connection which is more long standing. The Foundation has applied to re-join The Federation, and the proposal was carried unanimously at our last committee meeting.

The Executive Committee met with various association representatives at the AGM on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> September last year during the Festival weekend in Ely, and again virtually using Zoom on 1<sup>st</sup> March this year. We hope to meet again, but this time in person in Learnington, in July this year.
